

Boys and Girls Club Expansion Begins

The members of the East Scarborough Boys And Girls Club on Galloway Road will have something special to remember this summer.

Their club is undergoing renovations and a huge expansion. A second floor is being added for offices and the gym expanded. With the potential of 1,200 or so sidewalk super-intendents, the job should be well done, although members would be advised to stay away from construction areas.

Elected officials from three levels of government

took part in the official ground breaking in late June. All three are contributing money toward the project. Mayor David Miller made the trip from downtown. The City share alone is \$1.5 million.

There has been an obvious need to expand the building for several years now. Councillor Paul Ainslie recalls that when he was a kid, he and his brother were able to come over from their nearby home and had the run of the place. The Club was originally built by local initiative with funds from the United Way.
